



Getting Started with Trimble Connect

Trimble Connect provides the right people with the right data at the right time - enabling teams to easily collaborate and make informed decisions. To make things even easier, this quick guide provides 10 simple steps to getting started with Trimble Connect.


Step 1: After purchasing a license at connect.trimble.com, use your Trimble ID to [login to Trimble Connect](#). Once logged in, click the “New” button to begin your project.




Step 2: Enter the name of your project. You may also wish to provide additional details to help your team easily identify the project.




Step 3: Now that your project is created, you can add or create project data by clicking the “Add” button in the upper left corner.




Step 4: Upload all of your project files by clicking the “Upload Files” button (For a complete list of compatible file formats, click [here](#)).




Step 5: Keep your project organized by creating a customized folder structure. This allows you to easily group project files together or even assign access permissions as needed.




Step 6: Keep your project up-to-date by downloading the sync tool and easily synchronizing your project files from your desktop.




Step 7: Create your team by clicking the “Team” tab and then click on “Invite” to invite project members.




Step 8: Also under the “Team” tab, you can easily edit a project member’s role as well as their user permissions to ensure the right people have access to the right data.




Step 9: To begin collaborating, click on the “Data” tab. Under “Explorer”, you can select from your available project files and view them by clicking “View in 3D Viewer”.



Step 10: Easily view, review, annotate, and collaborate on your project by utilizing the various features provided in the 3D Viewer.
